(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER DECEMBER 2021

To allow pole testing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Nethergong Hill & The Glen, Upstreet.

A closure is planned from 6th December 2021 at 09:30, with estimated completion by 6th December 2021 at 15:30, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC008PTMS179835B-01 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Nethergong Hill & The Glen will be closed from the junction with A28 to outside Nethergong Farm, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while pole testing works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Sandpit Hill, Hollow Street, Marley Lane, Church Road, Hoath Road, Babs Oak Hill, A28 Staines Hill, Island Road and vice versa.
