THE GLEN, SANDPIT HILL AND NETHERGONG HILL, CHISLET

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that The Glen, Sandpit Hill and Nethergong Hill, Chislet will be closed to through traffic, on or after 2nd August 2022 for up to 1 night.

The road will be closed at The Glen.

The alternative route is via Church Lane, Boyden Gate Hill, Highsted, Ford Hill, Maypole Road, Hoath Road, Babs Oak Road, A28 Staines Hill and A28 Island Road.

It is planned that the road will be closed between 21:00 hrs and 03:00 hrs.

This closure is necessary to enable lining road works to be carried out by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.
