A28 Island Road, Upstreet

(40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER OCTOBER 2022

To allow new connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily impose a 40 MPH speed limit on part of A28 Island Road, Upstreet, from the existing speed limit sign (at the side of 145 Island Road) for a distance of approximately 400 metres in an Easterly direction.

The speed restriction is planned from 24th October 2022, with estimated completion by 28th October 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (EB006-34949323_1-02 - South East Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on One.Network

The speed restriction is required for the safety of the public and workforce while new connection works are undertaken by South East Water.
