A28 Island Road, Upstreet

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER FEBRUARY 2023

To allow connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of A28 Island Road, Upstreet.

A closure is planned from 7th February 2023, with estimated completion by 10th February 2023, or where stated on a valid Permit (EB006-37594696-02 - South East Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on <u>One.Network</u>

Island Road will be closed in the general vicinity of numbers 1 and 2 Wall End Cottages, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while connection works are undertaken by South East Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via A28 Island Road, Canterbury Road, A299 Thanet Way, Herne Street, Canterbury Road, Calcott Hill, Herne Bay Road, Sturry Hill, A28 Island Road, Staines Hill and vice versa.
