& Chislet**

**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

TEMPORARY ORDER JULY 2021

To allow fibre connection and other associated civil works to complete BT spine works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on Hollow Road, Old Tree Road & Mill Road, Hoath & Chislet.

Closures are planned from 5th July 2021, with estimated completion by 10th August 2021. The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

The following roads will be closed, on a rolling basis with only one road closed at a time, as detailed below.

Hollow Road, Hoath & Chislet

The roads will be closed on the following dates:

- Hollow Road, Chislet - from 5th July 2021, with estimated completion by 16th July 2021.
- Hollow Road, Chislet & Hoath - from 10th August 2021 for up to 1 day between the hours of 09:30 and 15:30.

Hollow Road will be closed between the junctions with Church Lane and Old Tree Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Church Lane, Old Tree Road and vice versa.

Old Tree Road, Hoath

The road will be closed on the following dates:

- From 19th July 2021, with estimated completion by 30th July 2021.
- From 10th August 2021 for up to 1 day between the hours of 09:30 and 15:30.

Old Tree Road will be closed between the junctions with Mill Road and Hollow Road (Hoath), to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Hollow Road, Church Lane, Hollow Street, Marley Lane, Church Road, Mill Road and vice versa.

Mill Road, Hoath

The road will be closed from 2nd August 2021, with estimated completion by 6th August 2021.

Mill Road will be closed between the junctions with Old Tree Road and School Lane, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via School Lane, Maypole Lane, Old Tree Road and vice versa.

The closures are required for the safety of the public and workforce while BT spine works are undertaken by Openreach.
