4 KCC & CCC Cllr reports

KCC Cllr Marsh reported that the KCC budget had still not been signed off although Council tax would only increase by 5%. Alan also spoke about issues around young unaccompanied asylum seekers and the huge costs borne by KCC caring for them

There was a discission about the speed sign near Chislet School which had been out of order for a considerable time, and frustration expressed that it was not working when all that may be needed was a new battery
